



GENERAL INFORMATION 9-BALL DOUBLES TOURNAMENT

Tournament Room – The tournament room is in The Westgate Convention Center. This is a non-smoking venue.

Hotel Check-in – Unless you've made other specific arrangements, your room(s) will be reserved for Friday and Saturday nights. You may check-in at the front desk any time after 4 PM on Friday. The room and tax portions of your lodging have been paid and there will be no energy surcharge or resort fee, but you will be on your own for incidentals (phone, etc.) for which the Westgate will require either a \$50 credit card or \$200 cash deposit. You **MUST** check in Friday evening or you risk losing your room

Team Registration – Each team must register in the tournament room prior to the tournament. A completed and signed Skill Level Certification Form is required in order to register. You may register Thursday evening from 6:00 PM to midnight or Friday between Noon and 7:00PM.

Practice – The Tournament room will be open for practice Thursday, late afternoon. Once the event has begun, you will be allowed to practice on any table that is not being used for the main tournaments or minis. Tables will be open throughout the weekend. Please keep in mind that any practice game you start could be interrupted if the table is needed for one of the tournaments or a mini.

Players' Meeting – MANDATORY 7:30 PM on Friday. Missing this meeting may result in your disqualification from the tournament. We will be going over the rules of play and making sure everyone understands the differences between regular league night rules and those that apply to this tournament. Please note Local Bylaws do not apply. Both players should plan on attending the meeting.

Main Tournament – Start time will be Friday after the players' meeting. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the tournament should start on time. Saturday's matches will be played Saturday evening. Depending on the size of the field, the last few rounds may be moved to Sunday morning.

Mini Tournaments – We will be holding Mini Tournaments Thursday late afternoon, Friday evening and Saturday. You should have plenty of opportunities to compete in mini-events, each with a field of 8 to 16 players and an entry fee of \$10 to \$20.

Skill Level Cards – You will need to obtain a Skill Level Verification Card in order to sign up for minis. No one will be allowed to sign-up for a mini without a card. Players in the main tournaments will receive skill level cards at registration, but individuals not participating in either of those events will be required to pay a \$10 green fee to obtain a skill level card.
