American Poolplayers Association Message Board

The South OC APA Message Board will be activated this month, allowing players to communicate with each other and with the league office. In order to use the Message Board, you must create and login to an APA Member Services online account. This is a national account with access to player history from all areas played. When you login and access the message board, this will take you to the local South Orange County message board if you are active in this area. From here you can post message "threads" to which other users can reply. We will be setting up **Forums** that categorize message threads for easier viewing and responding. Users will also be able to send private messages to other message board participants. *We will also be communicating league messages to users of the Message Board, so we encourage all players to* **create an online Member Services account**.

The Spring Session Has Started... NEW TEAMS ON EVERY NIGHT OF PLAY!

Teams can still be added through the fourth week of play, so visit the **Player Incentives** page online and build your team today!

This session we will still have only one division per night, with at least ten teams in each division. However, in the next session over the Summer, we will be splitting larger divisions based on area (north and south). Below are the current formats on each night of play.

Rosters for the Spring Session should be finalized by the fourth week of play, and these are the players who will compete in the South County Local Team Championships (LTC) and at Nationals in Vegas. If your team qualified in the Summer or Fall Sessions, you'll need at least 4 players to continue playing in the Spring to keep your eligibility. All players must have at least 10 lifetime matches (by end of Spring) and 4 Spring Session matches to play in the LTC. This is a monthly newsletter published on the first Monday of each month.

Doubles and Masters Leagues

The Fall session for Doubles and Masters is still in progress and <u>teams can</u> <u>still join</u>, with winners qualifying for the Doubles National Championships in Vegas. We have multiple slots available for these events, so we will run additional qualifiers (either leagues or tournaments) in the Spring.

Open Doubles Monday Nights: Any player combination with no Skill Level cap ♦ Scotch Doubles (alternate shot) ♦ Match Points Race based on combined Skill Level ♦ Play one match each of 8- & 9-Ball

Masters Saturday Afternoons: 3- to 4-person teams, three play per team match ♦ No handicap ♦ All players welcome (APA membership required upon play) ♦ Individual match is US Amateur Format (Race to 7: 8 games of 9-Ball/5 games of 8-Ball)

2010 Annual APA Membership Due on the First Night You Play

Please include membership fees along with the weekly team fees for all players on the first night they play. Annual APA dues are \$25 per person, unless they joined after August 15, 2009, in which case the dues are prorated at \$15. Anyone who joined in December 2009 is paid through the end of 2010. The amount owed for each player is listed next to the player's name on the rosters of each scoresheet.

TEAMS WITH AN ASTERISK

If your team name is preceded by an asterisk, which is a default setting for all teams, then your team may not be asked to bend the rules. If you don't mind being approached to bend a rule on occasion (captains must agree), then please ask the league office to remove the asterisk from your team name.
