



How to win up to \$15,000 at the Poolplayers Championship

To get started, you must have played a minimum of 10 matches within the last 2 years. 8-Ball matches is separate from 9-Ball. All players are encouraged to participate!

LOCAL BOARDS

Local leagues run different types of boards to qualify players for Regionals.

Singles Board: Minimum \$25 entry, 8 players, **1 winner**, Single elimination. (12.5% chance of winning)

4-1 Board: Minimum \$45 entry, 4 players, **1 winner** (25% chance of winning)

Splash Board: Minimum \$55 entry, 16 players, **5 winners**, double elimination. (31.25% chance of winning)

Best Chance Board: Minimum \$78 entry, 16 players, **7 winners** (43.75% chance of winning)

You may not buy a board; you must show you won at least 2 rounds on a board for National Office to accept entry.

JUNE 16 - NOVEMBER 30

LOCAL BOARDS

Singles Board: Minimum \$25 entry, 8 players, **1 winner**, Single elimination. (12.5% chance of winning)

4-1 Board: Minimum \$45 entry, 4 players, **1 winner** (25% chance of winning)

Splash Board: Minimum \$55 entry, 16 players, **5 winners**, double elimination. (31.25% chance of winning)

Best Chance Board: Minimum \$78 entry, 16 players, **7 winners** (43.75% chance of winning)

You may not buy a board; you must show you won at least 2 rounds on a board for National Office to accept entry.

Every year in April or May the APA hosts the Poolplayer Championships at the Westgate in Las Vegas. Players who win at Regionals will receive paid accommodations, travel assistance, a prize package and a slot to compete for the grand prize. All standard APA rules apply, normal handicap race, modified single elimination brackets.

8-Ball Classic offers five Skill Level Tiers:

- Blue Tier (skill levels 2-3)
- Yellow Tier (skill level 4)
- Red Tier (skill level 5)
- Orange (skill level 6)
- Purple Tier (skill level 7)



The champion of each tier in this event receives \$15,000 in cash and prizes.

9-Ball offers four Skill Level Tiers:

- Green Tier (skill levels 1-3)
- White Tier (skill levels 4-5)
- Gray Tier (skill levels 6-7)
